## It is good to be together - Connecting with the Thai Church

We had the privilege of joining the Thai pastors in their annual meeting in central Thailand. Here we were able to be introduced again, connect, and hear about the kinds of ministry each location is performing and how God is moving amongst the churches here.

We heard how in the last four years, five new churches have been planted. One location has at least 20 people waiting to be baptized. There is a shortage of ordained ministers in the Church of God in Thailand, and so they have to wait for an ordained minister to travel to that church before this celebration can take place. One woman even shared how she is travelling from village to village in her province and taking up soil in each village and claiming it as God's village. They share the gospel as they go. Tim was able to bring a message about unity to encourage the pastors as well. We are thankful for the work God is doing in Thailand and look forward to seeing how we can partner with individual locations to see God's kingdom continue grow in this country.
