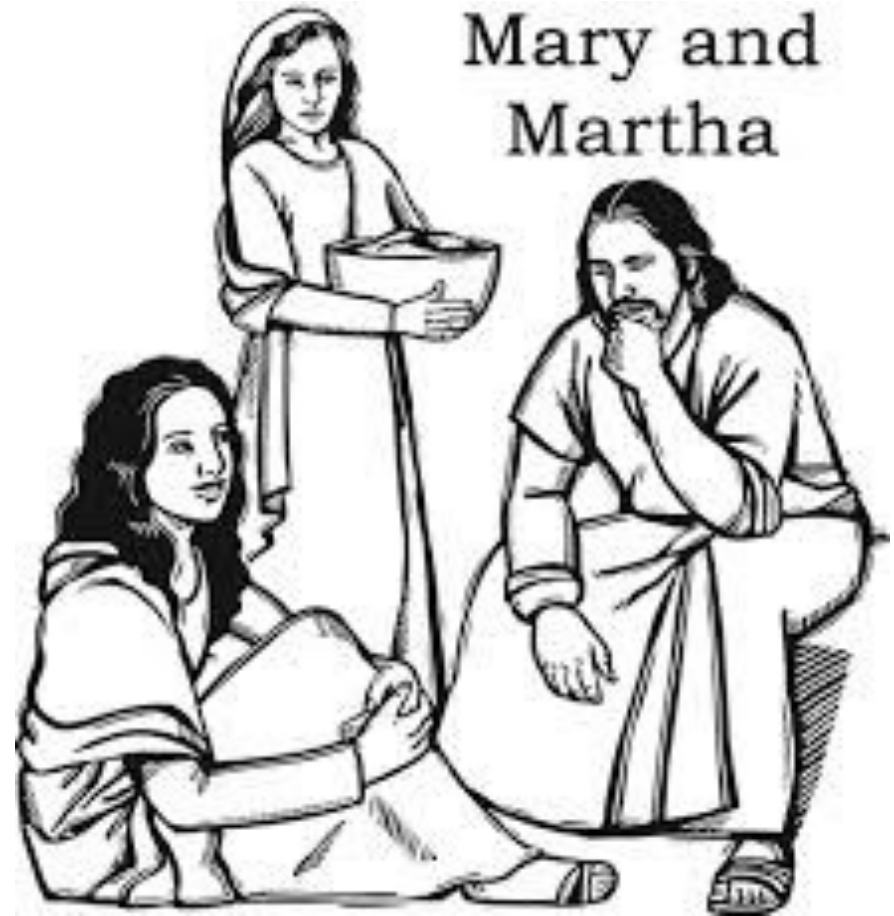

VI Conclusion

A. Mothers, do not fear condemnation if you are in Christ Jesus. You stand righteous because of Christ's work on your behalf on the cross. Even though you may feel you are, you are *not* condemned

by messy homes  
by your personal sins  
by your miscarriages  
by your lack of desire to have more kids  
by your inability to cook  
by being divorced  
by your desire to be alone, away from the kids for a time  
by your body, which may not be what it once was  
by your failures as a mother  
by your rebellious children  
by the frustration of having to daily repeat yourself  
by all the fears and tears which take you to the precipice of despair  
by not being able to throw the party of the century for your kids  
for not feeding your kids meals that could only be made after a trip to Whole Foods  
by your need for a vacation  
for not living up to the standards of your Mother or Mother-in-law  
by the stares of those who have no kids when your kids erupt into volcanic screams in public places
