A CHRISTIAN PERSPECTIVE ON WAR

- I. INTRODUCTION The American Civil War General William Sherman said, "War is hell!"
 - A. The realistic images of war.
 - 1. With war comes conquest and hostility, economic disaster, illness, and death.
 - B. But war is not hell. It is only the foretaste of hell.
 - C. However, war raises a multitude of questions.
 - 1. Where does war fit into God's plans?
 - 2. Is God on our side?
 - 3. How does war look from God's perspective?
 - 4. What should Christians be <u>praying for</u>, <u>hoping for</u>, and <u>expecting to happen?</u>
- II. BODY Five different attitudes to war
 - A. First there are the doves,
 - 1. These are the pacifists who are opposed to all war and all violence. Isa. 2:4; Isa. 11:6
 - 2. We are in the fallen world of human sinfulness Romans 13:1; 1 Peter 2:13-14
 - B. The second attitude is the opposite: the hawk.
 - 1. The person who is always looking for a fight Ps. 11:5, ESV, James 1:20. Prov. 3:31-32.
 - C. The third and fourth attitudes are neither pacifistic nor militaristic.
 - 1. The difference between them is timing. Ecc. 3:8.
 - 2. This then is the third position. "Not yet"
 - D. The Forth attitude is that of "at last" we have had to act.
 - 1. Wars are ours, not Gods. Prov. 24:6. Luke 14:31-32.
 - E. And then the fifth and final attitude: the fence.
 - 1. Many of us feel ourselves unable to decide.
- III. CONCLUSION: Paul tells us to pray for those in government over us "that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness" (1 Tim. 2:2).
