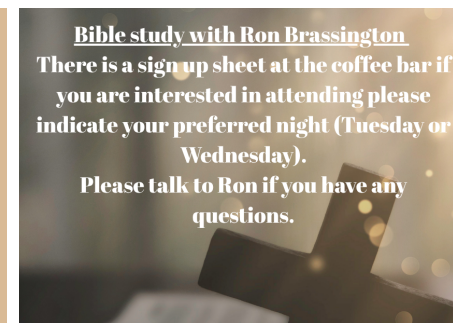
Children's Church

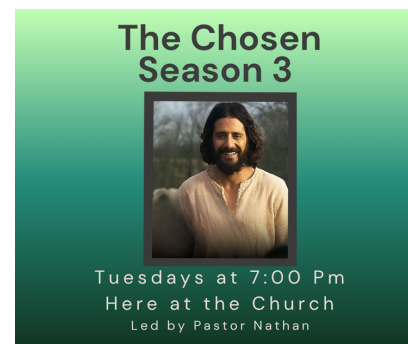
The Church is turning 80
