SOLICITOR'S REPORT

Solicitor Mathew Pierron informed Council that the County wants to give 104 Auld St. to the Village of Gettysburg. Pierron went on to state that there are \$10,000 plus in back taxes and assessments; which would become the Village's responsibility. Pierron explained the way around the taxes and assessments would be to let the property go to Sheriff's Auction and hopefully get it cheap. Pierron then reminded Council that the property could auction at the same, or even higher, cost than the back taxes and assessments. Councilwoman Karla Harmon motioned to wait and purchase the property at Sheriff's Auction. Councilman John Archey seconded. **Roll Call:** Karla Harmon - yes; John Archey - yes; Tim Bryan – abstained; Jon Michael Shives - yes; and there were not enough votes to approve purchasing 104 Auld St. at auction.

Fiscal Officer/Village Administrator Jesse Berry read from his report. Berry commented on the flower beds recently installed in front of the Village Office; crediting Susan Parkman, Cheryl Byers, Michael Johnson Sr. and Councilman John Archey. Berry then mentioned landscaping plans for the Gettysburg Memorial Point. Berry then went on to update Council on Arts Week donations from local business. A small discussion ensued. Berry also commented on the problem with Villagers putting trash in the recycling bins, further insinuating they (he and other Village personnel) are aware of who some of the culprits are. Berry stated is was sad that one of these particular Villagers come to Council meetings regularly, in guise of a 'concerned and caring' citizen who wants to 'help' the community, but won't comply with certain ordinances and resolutions, who will constantly attack the Village administration on social media, and do things like put their trash in a county provided recycling dumpster, and has been known to dump trash and waste in the woods adjacent to the Council House.
