MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Donnie Harmon shared a letter from the Darke County Commissioners letting us know we were approved for the CBDG Grant. Harmon also wanted to give an assessment of his first 6 months as Mayor. He felt things were going great and that Susan and Heather were doing an outstanding handling their jobs, council was doing great and zoning was doing a good job.
