<b>Hebrews 10:25 NLT</b> <sup>25</sup> And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.	<b>Hebrews 10:25 KJV</b> <sup>25</sup> Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.</p>	<p><b>Romans 13:11-12 KJV</b> <sup>11</sup> And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. <sup>12</sup> The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.</p>

How can light live with darkness? <sup>15</sup> What harmony can there be between Christ and the devil<sup>[a]</sup>? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> And what union can there be between God's temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God said:</p> <p>"I will live in them and walk among them. <p><b>Galatians 6:9 AMPC</b> <sup>9</sup> And let us not lose heart <i>and</i> grow weary <i>and</i> faint in acting nobly <i>and</i> doing right, for in due time <i>and</i> at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen <i>and</i> relax our courage <i>and</i> faint.</p>	<p><b>Galatians 6: 9 KJV</b> <sup>9</sup> And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 40:31 NKJV</b> <sup>1</sup> But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew <i>their</i> strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.</p>	<p><b>Isaiah 40:31 KJV</b> <sup>31</sup> But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.</p>
