Vice Chairperson Joe Heyrman called the meeting of the Friends of Townsend Fire Membership to order at 9:30 a.m.

Deb Franzen made a motion to approve the April 20, 2024 meeting minutes, seconded by Linda Vander Heiden, motion carried.

Firefighter Memorial Plaques

- Dacon Franzen and Chief Herlache to create criteria for name placement; that is, retirement or in memory of (an active member of the fire department who has passed).
- Recognition portion of plaque is for active years of service; 5, 10, 15 years in 5-year increments.
- Chief Herlache to provide list of names for both the retirement and in memory of plaques.

Grant Writing – Dawn Herlache

- Dawn Herlache & Ray Scheifen have found a website specifically geared toward grants that may be available to FOTF.
- Membership made a recommendation to have the Grant Committee tour the fire station, so they have a full understanding of what the fire department needs entail. This will provide a better understanding of the types of grants the committee needs to go after.
- Dacon Franzen indicated that the CWDG grant for \$18k was decline. Dacon will investigate why the CWDG declined the grant.

<u>July 4th Event – Deb Franzen</u>

- Volunteer's need to visit assigned area businesses by June 1, 2024.
- Deb Franzen has two pallets at her house to store prizes.
- Deb Franzen discussed and passed the volunteer sign-up sheets for the event.
- A big thank you to Bruce and Pam VanOss for stamping and labeling the raffle ticket envelopes.
- May 22nd at 6:00 p.m. meet at the fire station to stuff three bundles of raffle tickets and a letter into the envelopes.
- Posters are available for posting in local businesses.
- Miller has provided two banners. One to be place on the overhead of the service door and one on the fence at the dump.
- Deb Franzen has created "cheat sheets" for ticket sales, i.e., 6 tickets at \$2 = \$12, etc.
- Meat raffle pricing
 - o Currently at \$2 per ticket, do we need to raise the cost of tickets?
 - Deb Franzen to do the math to see what type of profit FOTF would make at \$2 and \$3, after expenses.
