It is with great sorrow and regret at the actions of the CBC Board and Matt Whitlock, that I must inform you effective immediately I resign from my position of Accounting Director with Capo Beach Church. I believe resigning from my position is my only option at this point, due to my loyalty to God and His principles, the CBC staff, Craig and Jeanne. I can not in good conscience serve the current leadership that is participating in the activities described below.

As you can imagine, this has been brewing for many months and I don't take this departure from the duties I have faithfully performed for nearly 14 years at Capo lightly. I have bathed this decision in prayer and am confident in this timing and direction. With Craig's employment termination and treatment over the last few months, I can not stand by and continue to work under this board and Matt. It would be a dishonor to the legacy Craig and Jeanne built through their faithful hard work and dedication to this community for over 40 years. They are a treasure to the people of Capo and should be treated as such. I will miss serving my God at Capo under Craig's loving leadership.

I look forward to seeing how the Lord accomplishes His will. These are the behaviors I have observed over the last few months that have no business in a church:

-a board that seem to have scales on their eyes as they worship the teaching pastor (a man) and vow to keep him happy by any means necessary no matter the cost. This blind devotion has resulted in Craig's termination, tremendous division among staff, leaders and church members, unbelievable stress and heartbreak

-prideful self ambition to take control of God's house and the division it is causing

-lack of transparency that has washed over the church as the board and Matt plan a transition toward "a model that better aligns with their future vision", as stated in Matt and Bruce's email dated 1/8/25. Yet all questions from staff asking for clarity have been met with no response or a standard response saying - let's meet one-on-one.

-leadership that doesn't seek input of the staff or members on such huge transitions

-leadership that silences Craig's voice, truth and leads people to think he did something to deserve this treatment

I would love nothing more than to continue the work God appointed me to but the He has made it clear this board and Matt would have to resign and Craig would have to be reinstated to his lead pastor position.
