

## Chapter H Actives Cancelled

As of November 3, 2020 all GWRRA Kansas Chapter H activities are cancelled for November and December. Watch your email for updates.

### Reasons:

1. The number of cases in our general area are rising more rapidly than ever before.
2. There are numerous cases of asymptomatic or mild symptom carriers unknowingly transmitting the virus to others. ("It's just a cold")
3. The vast majority of our chapter members fall into the high-risk category.
4. A number of people have already informed us that they planned on staying home from our meetings for the next 2 months due to the increase in cases in our area. They do not want to risk contracting the virus that would either keep them from visiting their family or unknowingly spread it to their family during the holidays

### Background:

While there is no official state or county mandate at this time to limit meeting size, the general consensus of the leadership team was to put Chapter H on HOLD till after the holidays. We don't like doing this, we are a friendly, talkative group that enjoy each other's company. But for the safety of our members in the long run, this is thought to be the best option at this time.
