# **Job Description:**

The Equipment Repair Technician coordinates and executes the maintenance and repair of laboratory rental instrumentation, predominantly focused on portable X-ray fluorescent (XRF) instruments, the diagnosis of instrument errors and both software and hardware repair. The candidate should have experience working on several different portable XRF analyzers and feel comfortable and confident in basic repairs as well as liaising with vendor repair shops. The position is expected to develop and maintain a workspace with the tools, equipment, and components necessary for keeping a fleet of instruments operating. This includes instruments from Bruker including the CTX and Tracer series, Olympus Delta, Niton Gold, Spectro Scout and other portable XRF. The candidate should be prepared to continue learning by attending any critical training programs to familiarize themselves with all rental tools offered by RohmTek.
