- QA/QC collected data and deliver tabulated results to internal technical team for review prior to client delivery.
- Maintain a working knowledge of the various instrument functions and troubleshoot as maintenance is needed.
- Track inventory and usage of lab consumables to ensure adequate supplies are kept to complete testing without delay.
- Maintain catalog of raw and calibrated data according to lab designated file system.
- Dispose samples at end of each project based on supervisor and client directions.
- Occasional field and wellsite work required based on project specifications.
