

Weathersfield Township Annual Veterans Banner Program Announcement

- The Weathersfield Township Board of Trustees is proud to announce the Annual Veterans Banner Program for 2026. This program provides a meaningful way for our community to honor local veterans and active service members by displaying personalized banners throughout Township Park. Program details are available on our Facebook page or can be picked up at our Administration Building during regular business hours Monday – Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM.

Program Details:

- Up to 52 banners will be installed on the light poles located in the Township Park.
- Banners will be displayed annually from Memorial Day through the end of October.
- After the display period, banners will be returned to the veteran, their family, or sponsor as a keepsake.

How to Apply:

- Banner orders will be accepted beginning February 2, 2026 through March 13, 2026.
- Due to the limited number of available spaces, orders will be processed on a first-come, first-serve basis once payment is received.
- Each applicant may initially apply for up to two banners. Additional banners may be available after March 13, 2026, depending on the number of orders received.

Cost and Payment:

- Each banner costs \$100.
- Payment methods accepted: check, money order, or cash (no credit cards).
- Payments must be made in person at the Weathersfield Township Administration Building, located at 1451 Prospect Street, Mineral Ridge, Ohio, during regular business hours Monday – Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM.
- Checks or money orders should be made payable to Weathersfield Township.

After Payment:

- Once payment is made, you will receive a receipt securing your banner(s).
- Detailed instructions will be provided for submitting the necessary information to Cole Creative Design to create a personalized banner for your Hometown Hero.

Important Information:

- No requests for specific banner locations will be accepted.
- The Township is not responsible for any banners that may be damaged due to weather or vandalism.

This program is a unique opportunity for families to honor their loved ones who have served or are currently serving our nation. It also provides our community with a powerful way to reflect on the sacrifices made by these brave men and women.
