Dear Members of the Board:

As we end the first month of 2019, I have reflected on 2018, and feel a sense of pride and gratitude. I am proud of our officers, township administrator and trustees; I am grateful for their hard work and dedication to our department. It would be impossible to share all of our achievements and accomplishments in 2018, but I am writing to provide a summary.

In 2018, we continued to modernize our department by purchasing five new patrol vehicles (Ford Interceptors SUVS). We are proud to say that our fleet is modernized, including our spare 2013 patrol sedans. In addition to vehicles, we acquired the software package Sundance Systems, Inc and E-Citations that have been installed in every patrol car, allowing officers to print and send citations directly to the court. Sundance pulls data from past reports and creates reports to aid in investigating current crimes. We have also invested in new computers for our officers and clerks, as well as mobile data terminals and tasers.

Our officer safety and continuing knowledge is important; officers continued on-line training through OPOTA. The training was focused around victim rights and law updates. OPOTA training, as well as alert training, have brought our officers to a high educational standard and have the knowledge and tools to be successful in their roles. As we have in previous years, our department has taken extra classes in firearm training and tasers.

We have fulfilled our duty of providing the state with updated records by sending our completed department roster and yearly state mandated reports. There has been an updated policy and procedure regarding internal affairs from the state; however, our department had been following that procedure for some time, which resulted in state certification.

It has been a year full of professional development and we are proud to see several changes through the year. Melissa Murphy, police clerk, was promoted to the Zoning Inspector/Administrative Assistant II position. We are excited for Melissa in her new position and are grateful for her work and endless support. To assist Melissa, the department hired Lynda Briach. Lynda comes to Weathersfield Police with several years of experience as a dispatcher, LEADS Tac, and Supervisor of the Communication Room of the Warren Police Department. Lynda will be focusing her time on the impound lot, traffic camera collections, LEADS Tac, Parking Violation Bureau, along with other various administrative responsibilities.

I consider 2018 to be one of the department's most successful years, and I expect nothing less for 2019. Our vision for 2019 is clear and we have established goals. One goal I am most excited for, is to be a part of the state-wide MARC program, which should be up and running by March of 2019.

In closing, I wanted to personally thank the officers, administrators and trustees for their hard work and partnership over the past year. I am genuinely looking forward to continuing to work together to serve and protect the residents of Weathersfield Township.
