

Weathersfield Township 2020 Spring Clean-Up Week of May 11th to May 15th

The 2020 Spring Clean Up is planned for the residents who are currently signed up for trash collection in Weathersfield Township. Republic Services will collect the clean up material on the customer's regular trash collection day during the week of May 11th thru May 15th.

Items must be placed at the street or curb of the residential unit **no earlier than 5:00pm the evening prior to collection** and no later than 5:00am the morning of collection.

Items that **<u>cannot</u>** be collected include:

- * Tires, car parts or car batteries
- * **Untied** brush or branches
- * Hot ashes or embers
- * Construction materials
- * Propane & gas cylinders
- * Fluorescent light bulbs
- * Steel drums or barrels
- * Explosives
- * Dead animals
- * Sod, rock, brick and dirt
- * Animal feces
- * Any type or liquids
- * Liquid paint—Let paint completely dry out before placing empty cans in the trash.
- * Hazardous waste including: poisons, fuel, paint solvents, oil, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides, medical waste and hypodermic needles.

Branches or bushes should be no more than 3 feet in diameter and no longer than 4 feet in length and must be secured with duct tape or twine.

Any appliance that contains Freon must have a tag stating the Freon has been properly removed by a licensed technician. If the appliance contains Freon and does not have a proper tag, it will **<u>not</u>** be collected. (examples: air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators and dehumidifiers)

All material needs to be in trash cans or in trash bags. Loose items will not be collected.
