SPRING CLEANUP MAY 9-13, 2022

Your Regular Garbage Day

Each spring, Weathersfield Township provides a special clean-up service & scrap tire pick-up for Township residents, giving you the opportunity to reduce household clutter and get rid of unwanted household materials by placing them at curbside for pickup. Please take this opportunity to get rid of larger household items and larger quantities of items which may be too large to take with your normal trash normal collection. Residents may discard unlimited amounts of furniture, electronics, toys, trash, yard waste, appliances, etc. All trash must be placed in trash cans, large trash bags or boxes, and set in an organized manner at the curb, **Tires on the opposite side of drive.**

The spring clean-up service is provided **on your regularly scheduled trash pickup day.** Materials may be placed at curbside the day prior to pick-up date.

Items that WILL Be Collected:

- Furniture
- Bed springs and mattresses.
- Metal – piled separately – will be collected.
- Old appliances, including washers, dryers, stoves, TVs and hot water heaters will be collected. Air conditioners, refrigerators and dehumidifiers will not be collected unless they have a tag from a licensed refrigeration mechanic indicating the Freon has been removed.
- Lawn/yard equipment - must be drained of oil and fuel.
- Carpet - cut and tied into rolls which do not exceed 4 feet in length and 3 feet in diameter
- Other items must be bundled, bagged or boxed. Each bag or box should weigh less than 50 lbs.

Items that WILL NOT Be Collected:

- Car parts or car batteries
- Untied brush or branches – call the Township for free chipping service
- Hot ashes or embers
- Construction materials
- Demolition debris, sod, rock, brick and dirt
- Dead animals
- Steel drums (any size)
- Explosives
- Propane and Gas Cylinders
- Any type of liquids
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Liquid paint - let paint completely dry out before placing empty cans in the trash
- Hazardous waste including poisons, fuel, paint solvents, oil, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides, medical waste including all hypodermic needles
- Un-bagged animal feces

SCRAP TIRE PICK-UP MAY 9-13, 2022 (Township Collects)

There is a **limit of four car tires (off rims) per household, (curbside collection) large truck tires will NOT be accepted.** You can also drop-off your tires between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM during the collection week at the Township Administration Building at 1451 Prospect Street, Mineral Ridge, Ohio 44440.
