- The **Trustees would like to announce that their annual Memorial Day Ceremony has been scheduled for Monday, May 25, 2026 at 9:00 AM at our community park.**
- The **Trustees would like to remind our residents of the upcoming pickleball tournament that will be held at our Community Park on Saturday, May 23, 2026 at 8:00 AM with a rainout date of Sunday, May 24, 2026 at 8:00 AM.**
- The **Trustees would like to remind our residents that the 2026 Flag Day Festival** dates will be June 11, 12 and 13. The 2026 Flag Day Parade will be on Friday, June 12 at 6:00 PM.

 - The tree limbs must be placed at the curbside with all the cut ends aligned with each other toward the street.
 - No shrubs, stumps, roots, lumber, or railroad ties will be accepted. All tree limbs must be free from vines.
 - We are not a tree removal service; if you are having a tree professionally removed let them do the entire job, you must have them take the tree limbs as well.
- The **Trustees would like to mention that our annual street sweeping began last week and will continue until all of our roadways have been swept.**
- The **Trustees would like to announce that the state of Ohio burn ban is in place and that open burning is not permitted within the Township.**

26-052 **MOTION TO *ADOPT A PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF WEATHERSFIELD TOWNSHIP, TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO, ACKNOWLEDGING, RECOGNIZING, AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION AND GRATITUDE TO OFFICER ISAIAH BRAZOFSKY AND OFFICER BRANDON FREER FOR THEIR PROFESSIONALISM, COURAGE, AND LIFE-SAVING ACTIONS IN SERVICE TO OUR COMMUNITY***

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2026, Weathersfield Township Police Department Officers Isaiah Brazofsky and Brandon Freer were dispatched to the Salt Springs Road bridge above Interstate 80 in response to a welfare check involving a male subject sitting on the wall with his feet hanging over the bridge; and

WHEREAS, Officers Brazofsky and Freer arrived on scene within minutes and were confronted with an extremely dangerous and emotionally charged situation involving an individual in crisis who stated that he wanted to end his life; and

WHEREAS, Officer Isaiah Brazofsky, serving as the Officer in Charge, immediately requested the Ohio State Patrol to block traffic on Interstate 80 while both officers began calmly and carefully engaging with the individual; and

WHEREAS, through their professionalism, courage, patience, compassion, and sound judgment, Officers Brazofsky and Freer established rapport with the subject, de-escalated the highly volatile situation, reassured him, gained his trust, and ultimately persuaded him to safely come off the wall and walk over to the officers without the need for force; and

WHEREAS, as a direct result of their actions, the individual was safely taken into protective care and transported for treatment, thereby preserving human life and demonstrating the highest ideals of law enforcement service; and

WHEREAS, Chief Michael J. Naples, Jr. and Captain Kristopher W. Hodge commended both officers for their very professional actions in saving the life of this person, noting that despite having fewer than five years of service as police officers and never having previously handled a call of this nature, they acted without hesitation and brought the incident to a positive outcome; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees of Weathersfield Township desires to publicly acknowledge the extraordinary service of Officer Isaiah Brazofsky and Officer Brandon Freer and to express, on behalf of the Township and the entire community, sincere appreciation and gratitude for their dedication to protecting and serving others;

WHEREAS, the Weathersfield Township Board of Trustees established the annual Flag Day Festival in 2014 as a community celebration designed to bring residents together through family-friendly activities including rides, inflatables, games, live music, community fundraising efforts, and food vendors; and

WHEREAS, since its inception the Flag Day Festival has been conducted as a community event with no admission charge to residents, with only nominal fees associated with rides, inflatables, and games, and with fundraising efforts conducted each year to offset the costs associated with hosting the event; and

WHEREAS, Republic Services, the Township's residential solid waste collection contractor, has generously supported the Flag Day Festival each year since 2015 through financial contributions intended specifically to assist with the costs associated with hosting this important community event; and

WHEREAS, Republic Services will once again donate the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to Weathersfield Township in support of the 2026 Flag Day Festival; and

WHEREAS, the Weathersfield Township Board of Trustees has determined that these funds will be donated for the express purpose of supporting the Flag Day Festival and that the funds should be used exclusively for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has recently transitioned responsibility for organizing and hosting the Flag Day Festival to a community organization known as the Weathersfield Community Connection Partners, an Ohio Non-profit corporation, which will coordinate and conduct the 2026 Flag Day Festival for the benefit of the residents of Weathersfield Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to allocate the donated funds received from Republic Services to the Weathersfield Community Connection Partners to be used exclusively for expenses associated with the 2026 Flag Day Festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Weathersfield Township, Trumbull County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Board of Trustees hereby acknowledges receipt of a Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) donation from Republic Services intended to support the Flag Day Festival conducted for the benefit of the residents of Weathersfield Township.

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees hereby determines that the funds were donated specifically for the Flag Day Festival and that the funds shall be used exclusively for that purpose.

SECTION 3. The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the allocation and disbursement of the Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) donation to the Weathersfield Community Connection Partners, to be used solely for expenses associated with organizing and hosting the 2026 Flag Day Festival.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of any committees that resulted in such formal actions were conducted in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

26-068 **MOTION TO *ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE AND RESERVATION OF THE WEATHERSFIELD TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY PARK PICKLEBALL COURTS FOR A CHARITABLE TOURNAMENT EVENT IN MEMORY OF FIREFIGHTER THOMAS P. DONADEE.***

WHEREAS, the Weathersfield Township Board of Trustees is authorized pursuant to Ohio law, including but not limited to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 511, to manage, control, and permit the use of Township parks and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Township has invested in recreational amenities, including the pickleball courts at the Weathersfield Township Community Park, to promote community health, wellness, and engagement; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Adams, on behalf of the Youngstown Regional Pickleball Group, has requested the use of the Township's pickleball courts to conduct a charitable fundraising tournament; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said tournament is to support the family of the late Thomas P. Donadee, a dedicated public servant who faithfully served the Boardman Township Fire Department for nearly three decades, rising to the rank of Lieutenant and Fire Inspector, and who courageously battled cancer prior to his passing on December 22, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Donadee was widely respected for his commitment to his profession, his community, and his family, and was known for his passion for coaching youth, his love of athletics, and his enjoyment of pickleball as a recreational activity; and

WHEREAS, proceeds from the tournament will be donated to the Boardman Professional Firefighters Local 1176 fundraising efforts to support Mr. Donadee's family, including travel associated with his induction into the International Association of Firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that authorizing the use of Township facilities for this charitable and community-focused event serves a valid public purpose by honoring a life of service, supporting a family in need, and fostering regional community engagement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Weathersfield Township, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Weathersfield Township Pickleball Courts at the Community Park are hereby authorized and reserved for use by Mr. Bill Adams and the Youngstown Regional Pickleball Group for the purpose of conducting a charitable Pickleball Tournament on Saturday, June 27, 2026, from 8:00 AM until 1:00 PM, with a rainout date of Saturday, July 11, 2026, during the same hours.
