The Sick Leave Donation Policy was originally adopted through Resolution #13-100. The revised terms and conditions of the policy are set forth in the Sick Leave Donation Policy as established by our Township Legal Counsel. The effective date for the revised and amended Sick Leave Donation Policy shall be December 16th, 2014 and the board of Trustees may revise the Sick Leave Donation Policy from time to time through subsequent motions.

Sick Leave Donation Policy

The intent of this Sick Leave Donation Policy is to allow employees to voluntarily provide assistance to their co-workers who are in critical need of leave due to the serious illness or injury of the employee or a member of the employee's immediate family. Employees may donate sick leave time to other employees as set forth below.

- To receive donated sick leave, an employee must be on an approved leave of absence as a result of a serious illness or injury of the employee or the employee's spouse or minor child, or the death of the employee's spouse or minor child.
- In order to accept donated sick leave, the employee must have depleted or will deplete with the use of remaining leave hours his or her total available leave inclusive of sick leave, personal days, family days, vacation days, and birthday.
- 3. The employee must not have any documented sick leave abuse during the previous three (3) years.
- 4. A request for sick leave donation shall be submitted to the Township Administrator in writing on a designated form and shall be accompanied by documentation verifying the need for sick leave, including the time period during which the employee can reasonably be expected to be absent from work.
- 5. Any employee who elects to donate sick leave shall execute a form recognizing and agreeing that the donated sick leave shall be deducted from his/her accrued sick leave account and shall not be refunded.
- 6. The donation of sick leave shall not be considered an incident of absence or count against an employee's attendance bonus.
- 7. Sick leave must be donated in 8 hour increments.
- 8. An employee donating sick leave must retain a sick leave balance of at least one hundred twenty (120) hours after the donation.
- 9. No employee may accept donated sick leave beyond that which is needed to fulfill the length of the current leave of absence.
- 10. Donated sick leave may not be converted to a cash payment to the employee at retirement, voluntary termination, or otherwise.
- 11. All requirements for the use of sick leave must be followed when using donated sick leave.
