24-101 Motion to adopt a resolution to proceed with demolition of a structure which is unsafe, structurally defective, and unfit for human habitation.

PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2809 Pittsburgh Avenue, McDonald OH 44437 PERMANENT PARCEL NO. 23-111400, WEATHERSFIELD TOWNSHIP, TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.86 authorizes a Township Board of Trustees to declare structures within the Township to be a nuisance by reason of being insecure, unsafe, structurally defective, or unfit for human habitation, and to provide for the abatement of said nuisance by securing or demolition and removal of said structures; and;

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Board of Health at their meeting on November 15, 2023, declared the structure located at 2809 Pittsburgh Avenue, McDonald OH 44437 ("the Property") to be Unfit for Human Habitation; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted on February 13, 2024, the Board of Trustees of Weathersfield Township determined the Structure on the Property to be unsafe and structurally defective and ordered the Property Owner to demolish or repair the Structure within thirty days; and

WHEREAS, the Property owner was notified by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the Township's declaration of nuisance, right to request a hearing, and the demand to abate said nuisance by demolition, pursuant to RC 505.86(B) and(C) and there are no lienholders of record of the Property; and

WHEREAS the Property Owner requested a hearing before the Board of Trustees. The hearing was held on April 9, 2024 at 6:00 PM and was continued at the Property Owner's request to May 9, 2024 when additional evidence was taken; and

WHEREAS, the hearing was recorded by electronic means, and at the hearing, the Board of Trustees received evidence, including photographs of the property, copies of the Notices sent to the Property Owner, a letter from the property owner, and the testimony from the Property Owner; and

WHEREAS, at the hearing on May 9, 2024, the Property Owner stated that he wanted to enter into an agreement with the Board of Trustees pursuant to RC 505.86, providing that the Property Owner would complete the rehabilitation of the structure and obtain an occupancy permit by May 31, 2025, however the Property Owner subsequently refused to sign the Agreement.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Weathersfield Township, Trumbull County, Ohio, by authority of Section 505.86 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

- 1. The residential Structure on the Property located at 2809 Pittsburgh Avenue, McDonald OH 44437, is unfit for human habitation thereby constituting a direct threat to the public health and safety.
- 2. The Structure does not have working electric, plumbing, or HVAC systems.
- 3. The Board finds that the Structure must be removed to protect the health and safety of the township residents.
- 4. The Property Owner shall be notified in writing of the Board's decision, and of the Board's Order to remove the Structure. A party in interest who requested and participated in the hearing and who is adversely affected by the Order of the Board may appeal the order under Chapter 2506 of the Revised Code.
- 5. If the Property Owner does not demolish and remove the Structure within thirty days of the adoption of this Resolution, the Structure may be demolished and removed.
- 6. The total costs incurred by the Township for the removal of the Structure and all associated site restoration work shall be assessed to the owner(s) of record of the Property and the Weathersfield Township Fiscal Officer is requested to certify the total cost of the demolition, together with a proper description of the lands, to the county Auditor who shall place the costs upon the tax duplicate. The costs are a lien upon such lands from and after the date of entry. The costs shall be collected as other taxes and returned to the Township general fund.
- 7. This Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately, or upon the earliest date as otherwise allowed by law.
