Dear Members of the Board:

As 2020 concludes and we welcome 2021, I am sure everyone agrees that we can look forward to a much better year. The year was filled with new challenges and changes in the way we lived and worked. The Weathersfield Police Department was no exception: we faced many challenges in 2020 and I am very proud of how the officers handled the many difficult issues and changes. The officers took on many duties that were not police related or in their job description. I am very proud of their hard work and dedication to the Weathersfield Police Department and to Weathersfield Township.

In March 2020, the Township was forced to close the Weathersfield Township Administration Building. The police station remained open and officers on all turns-maintained communication with the public at the Administration building. Officers cleaned and disinfected the entire building daily while keeping the building secure. Police administration answered phones and directed calls to township employees who were working from home. I want the board to know that the officers and the Township's entire work force consistently operated efficiently and professionally under stressful times. Throughout it all, the Township never missed a beat.

In March, officers were ordered to limit their contact with the public. Officers were limited on patrol time and traffic stops. Officers handled calls from the station and would position themselves in sections of the Township or stationary patrol. Officers continued this practice until May. Then again in November and December, officers were ordered to limit contact and traffic stops for short times. All of this was due to the pandemic. Officers were ordered to wear protective gear when contacting the public on the road and while in the station.

The pandemic affected all of our programs and training in 2020. The department continued with training in firearms and taser for the yearly qualifications; the training was administered by Sgt. Lowery and Ptlm. Denno. Officers attended training at the Law Enforcement training center in Boardman with the FBI. The training included building searches and traffic stops. The rest of the training for 2020 was cancelled due to the pandemic. We expect the new year will bring the opportunity for more training for our officers.

I am Proud to say that all of our equipment is in excellent shape and our new upgraded radio system has been up and running without issue.

In closing, I look forward to 2021 and hope we can get back to normal sometime soon. I want to personally thank Captain Hodge for all of his hard work and dedication, both to the department and the Township. I would also like to thank all of the officers, Lynda, the Township Administrator, and the Township Trustees for all of their hard work and partnership over the past year.
