## **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.
- 2. The Board accepted the Minutes for the November 2005 Meeting.
- 3. Committee Updates:
  - a. Boat:
    - i. The Board attended the Marina Association's meeting regarding the proposed amendment change to restrict ownership of boat slips to individuals. Although the outcome of the voting was not announced at the meeting, it appeared that the vote was in favor of the amendment change. If the vote is in favor of the amendment change, the Villas will be grandfathered in and will be able to keep the four boat slips we have today under the ownership of our Association. Once we are advised of the outcome of the voting, we will communicate it to everyone.

## b. Landscape:

- i. Delcor accepted the Board's revised wording relative to 3<sup>rd</sup> party claims resulting in finalization of the Delcor Landscape Agreement.
- ii. Now that the Landscape Agreement is final, the Board is looking into getting updated quotes and formulating plans to upgrade the islands as soon as possible as well as looking into a consolidated plan to replace dead product in the common areas and complete the landscaping along the cart path leading to the tennis courts.

- 4. The 2006 FY budget was finalized and approved. Dues will be increased to \$95 for the coming year in an effort to increase the reserve levels.
