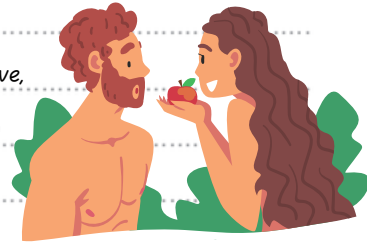

- cherubim: plural of cherub; an order of angels

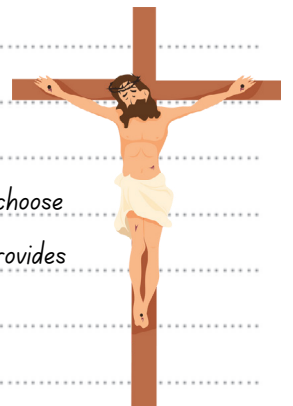
SUMMARY

- God created Adam and Eve and placed them into the Garden of Eden
- God placed the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil in the Garden and told Adam and Eve not to eat the fruit.
- Satan deceived Eve and she partook of the fruit
- Eve gave Adam the fruit
- Adam and Eve recognized that they were naked and hid from God
- God cursed Adam and Eve
- God provided clothing for Adam and Eve, then made them leave the Garden of Eden



REFLECTION/APPLICATION

- God did not force or compel Adam and Eve to obey His commandment: He allowed them to decide for themselves
- God did not protect Adam and Eve from the consequences of their actions
- God provided Jesus as redemption from the consequences of the Fall: overcome effects of death and sin
- God does not compel us either but allows us to choose to follow Him and accept the Salvation Jesus provides
