The focus of this presentation will be on teaching the importance of gun safety and handling. Instructors will show the class different types of firearms and how they function. We will talk about the different uses of each kind of firearm (rifle, shotgun, muzzleloader and handgun). There will be a history lesson on the heritage of firearms in the USA and what the importance of the 2nd amendment. At the conclusion of the class students will have an opportunity to see some of the firearms function with dummy/ inert ammunition while practicing the safety rules.
