



WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BAPTISM?

• It illustrates Christ's burial and resurrection.

"Christ died for our sins... He was buried... and He rose again."

1 Corinthians 15:3-4

"For when you were baptized, you were buried with Christ, and in baptism you were also raised with Christ." Colossians. 2:12

• It illustrates my new life as a Christian.

"When someone becomes a Christian he becomes a brand new person inside. The old life has passed away and a new life has begun!" --2 Corinthians. 5:17

"By our baptism then, we were buried with Him and shared His death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead... so also we may live a new life!" --Romans 6:4

Baptism doesn't make you a believer - it shows that you already believe. Baptism does
not "save" you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring - it's the
outward symbol of the commitment you make in your heart.

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith... it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast." --Ephesians 2:8,9

WHY BE BAPTIZED BY IMMERSION?

Because Jesus was baptized that way.

"As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water."

--Matthew 3:16

• Every baptism in the Bible was by immersion.

"...then both Philip and the man went down into the water and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water..." --Acts 8:38-39

• The word Baptize means "To dip under water".

The Greek word baptize means "to immerse or dip under water". It best symbolized a burial and resurrection!

• The founders of denominations agree:

Martin Luther... "I would have those who are to be baptized to be entirely immersed, as the work imports and the mystery signifies."

John Calvin... "The word 'baptize' signifies to immerse. It is certain that immersion was the practice of the ancient church."



John Wesley... "Buried with Him, alludes to baptizing by immersion according to the custom of the first church."

WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

• Every person who has believed in Christ.

"Those who believe and accepted His message were baptized..." --Acts 2:41

"Simon himself believed and was baptized..." -- Acts 8:13

"But when they believed Philip as he preached the Good News... and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women." --Acts 8:12

WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

As soon as you have believed.

"Those who believed ...were baptized...that day!" -- Acts 2:41

"Then Philip began with the scripture and told him the Good News about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water, and the man said, 'Look, here is water! Why shouldn't I be baptized right now?' Philip said, 'If you believe with all your heart, you may.' The man answered, 'I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.' So they went down into the water and Philip baptized him." --Acts 8:35-38

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can and should be baptized. If you wait until you are "perfect", you'll never feel "good enough"!

Crossroad Values & Maturity Statement

- We are actively engaged in our community as an active neighbor & citizen (INCARNATION)
 - I hang out here
 - I have relationships with neighbors
 - I feel & care about what's going on in my community
 - o I'm a regular in the local businesses & events
- My faith & relationship to Christ is clearly a priority & has impacted my values & decision making (DISCIPLESHIP)
 - o I meditate & communicate with God regularly in prayer
 - I read & study the Scriptures as a means to grow deeper in my knowledge & relationship to Jesus
 - Decisions about my time & money are made keeping my faith in mind
- My faith is a personal pursuit of & response to the grace of Jesus, not a psuedo-spiritual means to modify my behavior (GRACE)
 - I understand Jesus' gospel of grace. That we are invited to respond to the NEWS of Jesus' saving work on the cross. We do not earn right-standing with God, nor do we seek to maintain right-standing with God by "behaving"
 - I seek to view people with eyes of grace not judging them based on their differing lifestyles. I am not the morality police. I don't expect people to "clean themselves up" before I can connect with them. I can connect & befriend people who are vastly different from me
- I am intentional about cultivating community in my life and in those around me (COMMUNITY)
 - o I have relationships in my life that give me life/energy, hold me accountable, & spur me forward
 - o Not only am I "receiving," but I regularly invest in others to help them grow as well
- I live out my faith publicly with wise discernment of people's negative perspective on Christians
 & the shortcomings of Evangelicalism in America (PUBLIC FAITH)
 - I can and do talk about my faith in Christ regularly both with Christians & non-Christians
 - I am aware & sensitive to the myriad of polarizing issues affecting my community and how they view "Christians"
 - I am aware of the difficulties people have in opening up with Christians. I see their hesitations as valid
 - I deeply want everyone I know to put their faith in Christ. Although, this desire does not prevent me from having genuine friendships with non-Christians. Yes, I am praying & intentionally look for ways to share my faith with them and I am intentional about creating a safe space for them to converse about spiritual matters with me if they want. I do not force the issue.
- My heart breaks for the social injustices in our world including oppression, systemic racism, hunger & homelessness, sexism, trafficking, etc. (SOCIAL JUSTICE)
 - o I have a growing awareness of the myriad of social issues that plague our world.
 - o I am "in the fight" somehow seeking to join God in His work of redemption in this world. This is evident in my schedule & bank statements
 - I serve for the sake of bringing renewal, it is not a "means" to the end of evangelizing. Service is not transactional.

OUR MISSION

I understand that our mission is based on the Greatest Commandment & the Great Commission (Matthew 22:37-40 & Matthew 28:18-20). This is not a new idea. This is our purpose as laid out by Jesus - both as individuals & as a church.

It is my purpose to love God & to love my neighbor as myself.

It is my purpose to make disciples of all nations.

The church is a group of people who gather today in unity for these purposes.

Therefore, as a faith community, our purpose is the same.

Together we love God, love our neighbors, & multiply Christ-followers.

We want to see this here & now where we live in Jersey City.

TIME

I understand that my presence during Sunday Services, small group gatherings, & other Crossroad activities is the primary way I fulfill my role as a member. I'm aware that when I am absent, I am naturally leaving a gap that the other members will need to fill. This is especially true at our current size. My primary service as a launch team member is to be present and on time.

TALENTS

From the very conception of this church, we have always had a DNA of service. Serving is an undeniable aspect of our church culture, whether it's serving on our ministry teams, service projects, & alongside other neighbors at local community groups. God has built me with a specific S.H.A.P.E and I will make myself available to meet the needs of our community & our city. This is what God calls me to do.

TREASURES

I understand that it takes money to launch this church. Events, supplies, facilities, staffing & etc - it all takes money. So in commitment to this mission, I will invest financially by giving regularly. Furthermore, I understand that we are merely stewards. All that we own, including the money we've earned, ultimately belongs to Him. Still, God only calls us to bring back 10% of our earning as His - the tithe. I also understand that He calls me to give cheerfully. I will consider all these as I execute my giving plan.

MISSION

Pastor Paul is the Lead Pastor of this church start up, but I understand that I am called to this mission just as he is. Not only is the responsibility of this mission on Paul's shoulders, it's on mine too. I don't take this responsibility lightly.
