## What is the Legislation?

## How many Fire Wardens would I need on my site?

The number of Fire Wardens required would be different for every site. The size of the building, the works that go on and the risks that there are all contribute to the amount of Fire Wardens required. Holidays, sickness and shift patterns also determine the amount that need trained. The Fire Risk Assessment that would be carried out on your site would identify the amount required.
