**EMERGENCY CLEAN UP BUCKETS are very helpful to those in need!** As part of our mission trip, the youth are putting together buckets to be distributed through Church World Service. We are looking for the following items (OR monetary donations so we can purchase items):

- Five scouring pads (No stainless steel or pads with soap in them.)
- Seven sponges, including one large
- One scrub brush (With or without handle.)
- 18 reusable, lightweight multipurpose dry cleaning towels (No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels.)
- One 32-64oz. or two 25oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- One 16-34oz. bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap
- One 50-100ft. clothesline (Cotton or plastic line.)
- Five dust masks (N95 particulate respirator dust masks preferred; No surgical masks.)
- One pair of work gloves (Cotton with leather palm or all leather.)
- 20-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll
