He holds degrees from the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg, the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia, and Va. Tech.

Pr. Lee is looking forward to getting acquainted with you and sharing in the way Christ's ministry is being furthered through St. Paul's congregation. He plans to be available at the church office normally on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and at other times as well.
