



Pr. H. Lee Brumback II ("Pr. Lee") will be serving as St. Paul's minister during Pr. Burkhardt's sabbatical from July 18-Oct. 16, 2022. He served as pastor of St. Mary's ELC at Silver Run, Maryland, for 26 years, retiring at the end of 2017. He is married to Ann Keister Brumback and they have two adult sons, one who lives in Honolulu, Hawaii, and the other in Portland, Oregon. Growing up on a Shenandoah Valley farm near Winchester, Va., he has lived in Adams County for the last 34 years. Prior to seminary, Pr. Lee served in agriculture/administration with cooperative extension in New York and Virginia, and overseas with Lutheran World Relief and the Peace Corps in Jamaica, Vietnam, Fiji, Greece, and Ethiopia. He holds degrees from the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Gettysburg, the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia, and Va. Tech.

Pr. Lee is looking forward to getting acquainted with you and sharing in the way Christ's ministry is being furthered through St. Paul's congregation. He plans to be available at the church office normally on Tues. and Thurs. from 8:00 to 11:30 a.m., and at other times as well.
