GROCERY MINISTRY UPDATE:

For the month of September, we served 215 families (over 4 weeks) with 67 of those families having four or more people in their household. That's 570 people! We distributed more than 228 boxes, and at about 25 lbs per box, that's over 5472 lbs. of food.

We continued to be blessed by many volunteers:

- +16 volunteers on Friday this month
- +32 volunteers on Saturday this month
- +our teams include: Youth and Family, Troop 102, The Book Club, Congregation Council, and the Girl Scouts
- +every Friday, Bill Sowers picks up food donations at New Hope and brings them to St. Paul's to be organized for packing by volunteers and most weeks he picks up the 80 dozen eggs we give out each week
- +Nancy Smith keeps statistical records, and she and Deb Sowers communicate with the York County Food Bank for other donations and items to purchase
