# Which varieties of prayer do you engage?

#### Prayer expressing different emotions:

Jubilation (Luke 10:17-23), great distress (John 11:38-44), grief (Matthew 14:6-14), deep agitation (Luke 22:40-44)

## How do your prayers express emotion?

#### Praying in all sorts of places:

Wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11), Mountains (Luke 6:12-15), Houses (Luke 24:30), Boat (Matthew 8:26), Garden (Matthew 26:36-45), Public Areas (Matthew 19:13-15), On a Cross (Matthew 27:45-46)

## Praying at different times:

Early in the morning (Mark 1:35), over several days (Matthew 4:1-11), all night (Luke 6:12-15), during meals (John 17:1-23), after teaching (Matthew 19:13), after his baptism (Luke 3:21-22), before healings & miracles (John 11:41-42), after successful events (Luke 10:17-23), during times of distress (Matthew 26:36-45, 27:45-49, John 11:38-44)
