*A less predictable prompt system built for stronger stylized posts, stronger promotion, and more original visual directions.*



### **How to Use This Cheat Sheet**

This version was built to break you out of your usual defaults. Instead of reaching for the same beauty language, the same fashion cues, or the same polished art finishes, this sheet pushes you into stranger territory that still reads intentional, sharp, and valuable. The point is not to be random just to be random. The point is to create prompts that feel fresher, more collectible, and harder to scroll past.

Inside THE STYLIZED SOCIETY™ this helps members post work that looks considered instead of rushed. People can pull one item from each category, build a full prompt, and land on something with real shape, texture, mood, and identity. That makes the work stronger for group approval, stronger for engagement, and stronger for standing out in a feed full of fast, forgettable AI images.

Outside the group, these same combinations can become product covers, promo graphics, social campaigns, challenge posts, digital downloads, client concepts, avatar packs, printables, thumbnails, brand visuals, and paid creative services. AI tools are moving deeper into subscriptions, credits, and paid tiers across major platforms, so better stylized work is not just for fun anymore. Strong prompt systems can help create assets that actually earn back those monthly costs and turn promotion into profit.

### **Three Random Meta Prompts**

#### **Meta Prompt 1**

Use the uploaded subject as the identity base and randomly build a hyper stylized image by selecting one stylized art form, one stylization type, one medium, one avatar or character type, one angle, one pose, one fashion direction, and one finishing line from this cheat sheet. Keep the subject recognizable, but push the final image into a strange, polished, illustration heavy direction with layered textures, bold shape language, and a finish that feels editorial, collectible, and impossible to ignore.

#### **Meta Prompt 2**

Create a standalone Nano Banana prompt using this cheat sheet as a generator. Randomly mix two unexpected art forms, one tactile medium, one digital finish, one unusual character direction, one dramatic camera angle, and one expressive pose. Add one hyper stylized finishing line and make the final image feel like a luxury poster, a niche fashion collectible, and a visually loud piece of concept art all at once.

### **Meta Prompt 3**

Build a hyper detailed stylized prompt for an uploaded subject by choosing options from at least six different categories in this guide. Do not use the most obvious glamorous choices. Choose the stranger options, make the styling intentional, and write the final prompt in one cohesive paragraph so it feels like a complete art direction brief rather than a pile of random keywords. Keep the result highly promotable, highly stylized, and strong enough to post, package, sell, or turn into a branded series.

## **25 Unique Lines to Add to Any Prompt to Make It Instantly Hyper Stylized**

1. Render the final image like a strange collector item pulled from an impossible fashion archive.
2. Treat every surface as if it was hand worked, layered, and art directed with obsessive detail.
3. Push the anatomy and styling into a deliberate visual lie that still feels elegant.
4. Make the image feel like a museum object, a campaign visual, and a character concept at the same time.
5. Let the texture do real work so the image feels built, not merely generated.

6. Turn the subject into a stylized relic with sharp mood, unusual polish, and memorable shape language.
7. Make the rendering feel tactile enough to imagine touching every material in the frame.
8. Push the figure away from ordinary beauty and toward stranger, stronger design choices.
9. Give the final image the energy of a rare poster that people would save before they even read the caption.

5. Hands loosely hanging while the stance stays rigid
6. Seated sideways with one ankle sharply pointed
7. Leaning into an invisible wall
8. Arms crossed low with the chin slightly lifted
9. One hand pinching fabric while the other hand stays open
10. Body folded at the waist like a paper pattern
11. Standing tall with the weight dropped hard into one hip
12. Crouched low with the neck stretched upward
13. Back turned while the face cuts back toward camera
14. One knee bent inward with deliberate awkwardness
15. Hands framing the collarbone instead of the face
16. Shoulders raised with a bored pageant posture
17. Reclined with the wrists bent softly outward
