WEEK 1: WHO WE ARE — GOD’S FAMILY

SCRIPTURE

(1 Corinthians 12:12–14, 27; Psalm 133:1 — Summary for Students)

The Bible teaches that the Church is like a body made up of many different parts. Each part is important, and all work together as one. Even though people have different gifts and abilities, everyone belongs to Christ.

Psalm 133 reminds us that God is pleased when His people live together in unity and peace. When believers care for one another and work together, it brings joy and blessing. These Scriptures help us understand that we belong to God’s family and that how we treat one another matters.

MEMORY VERSE (NKJV)

“For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ.”

— **1 Corinthians 12:12**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Grades 3–5

Grades 6–8

- How do differences help strengthen the Church?
- Why is unity important among Christians?
- How can older students help create a welcoming classroom?

WEEK 2: HOW WE LEARN — THE BIBLE & PRAYER

SCRIPTURE

(2 Timothy 3:16; Psalm 119:105; Luke 11:1–4 — Summary for Students)

The Bible tells us that Scripture comes from God and teaches us how to live in a way that pleases Him. God’s Word helps correct us when we are wrong and guides us in making wise choices.

Psalm 119 describes God’s Word as a light that shows us the right path. Jesus also taught His disciples how to pray, giving them the Lord’s Prayer as a model. Through Scripture and prayer, we learn to listen to God and trust Him each day.

These passages remind us that Christians grow by reading the Bible and praying regularly.
