

# Christmas 1 & 2 Sunday School Student Handout

For Students in Grades 3 through 8

## Week 1: Christmas 1

### Scripture (Matthew 1:18–25, Summary for Students)

Mary was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit. Joseph was unsure what to do, but an angel appeared to him in a dream and said not to be afraid to take Mary as his wife. The angel told him the Child's name would be **Jesus**, because He would save His people from their sins. All of this fulfilled what the prophet said: *"Behold, the virgin shall be with child and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,"* which means **God with us**.

Joseph obeyed the angel and took Mary as his wife.

### Memory Verse (NKJV)

**"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."**

— Matthew 1:23

### Discussion Questions

#### Grades 3–5

1. What did the angel tell Joseph in the dream?
2. How do you think Joseph felt when he heard this message?
3. Why is Jesus called **Immanuel**?
4. How can we remember that God is with us?

#### Grades 6–8

1. What difficult choice was Joseph facing before the angel appeared?
2. How did God guide Joseph and help him understand His plan?
3. What does Matthew mean when he says this fulfilled prophecy?
4. What does "God with us" mean in your own life today?

1. What does Joseph’s immediate obedience show about his faith?
2. How does this story show God’s protection over Jesus?
3. How was prophecy fulfilled during the escape to Egypt?
4. What can this story teach us about listening to God’s guidance?
