Student Discipline

- 1. Riding a school bus is a privilege, not a right.
- 2. A student can lose this privilege, if his/her conduct is unacceptable.
- 3. While on a route, a school bus driver represents the school authority and is responsible for the safety and discipline of all passengers.
- 4. Students who ride a bus are subject to state regulations governing the use of these vehicles. Any misbehavior, which distracts the driver, jeopardizes the safety of everyone.
- 5. Drivers have been instructed to assign seats to all passengers and to treat passengers fairly and consistently.
- 6. Students must have a properly dated, written parental request to ride a bus other than their own to a destination other than their normal stop. The request must be approved and initialed by the student's principal or designee.
- 7. Students and chaperones are expected to cooperate with and obey drivers at all times.
- 8. Students are financially responsible for any damage to a bus for which they are wholly or partially responsible.
- 9. Drivers will make every effort to arrive at stops consistently.
- 10. Students are to be at the stop when the bus arrives.
- 11. Missing the bus is not an excusable reason for absence or tardiness to school.

The Following are Examples of Behavior that will Result In Disciplinary Action:

Failure to remain seated

Use of any tobacco product

Refusing to obey the driver

Threats or fighting

Throwing objects

Vandalism of any type

Excessive noise

Possession of a weapon

Lighting matches or lighter

Misconduct at the bus stop Defiance of school personnel

Use of profanity

General Guidelines for Bus Discipline

First Offense:

Conference with student

Second Offense:

Warning or 1-3 day bus suspension

Third Offense:

3-10 day bus suspension

Fourth Offense:

Bus suspension ranging from 10 days to the remainder of school year

*severe offenses may result in automatic suspension from the bus
