Spring Watercolor with Marci Mason

Saturday, March 21, 2020; 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. at the Monroeville Public Library Adult Watercolor Class (age 18 and older)

Inspired by the season of Spring, Marci Mason, noted and award winning Pittsburgh artist, will guide participants to create a delightful watercolor painting, "Tweet on a Twig" to celebrate the season. With spring a few weeks away, the lesson will focus on painting a lesson that incorporates several watercolor techniques, including salting, scratching, water marking, and dry brushing.

Participants will follow the instructor with step by step instruction and will receive a written tutorial that will coincide with the demonstration. The goal is to complete a painting to reflect the student's own interpretation of the still life.

The painting should be almost completely finished by the end of class. Marci Mason has done watercolor for over 30 years in the Pittsburgh region, has been an art instructor at Trinity Christian School over 20 years, and teaches adult classes in the evening hours.
