Facilities:

Toilets

We have three composting toilets located in the main camping area and within 150m from the shearing shed. Keep an eye out for log cabin style structures. BYO toilet paper. There are no communal showers on our property, however, showers are available at the Artesian Bore baths.

Water

There are numerous places to top us your tanks on our station:

- 1. By the stump on the way to the shearing shed
- 2. At the communal campfire
- 3. Close to #3 composting toilet

Washing Machine

A coin-operated washing machine located in the shearing shed, two x \$2 coins per load. BYO washing powder. Please don't use the machine to wash pet bedding.

Communal Campfire

The communal campfire is in the middle of the bush camping area. You are welcome to cook meals here. This campfire is managed by our volunteers, but if it's not already lit please feel free to light the fire using the wood provided. BYO cooking utensils and cookware.

Private Campfires

If you would like a private campfire, you are welcome to collect firewood off the ground from your surroundings. We ask you not to burn hollow timber, as we try and preserve as much habitat for our native wildlife as possible. Please do not cut down any trees.

Our walk-along farm tour is included in your stay and is conducted daily at 9am. We encourage our guests to join us to learn more about our farm and interact with our animals. Private bespoke farm tours are also available, please enquire at the time of bookings.

- There are no garbage facilities at Carinya station. Please take your rubbish with you and use the yellow garbage bins located opposite the Artesian bore baths.
- There are to be no drones used at any time without permission.
- Dogs must always remain on a leash, and owners must clean up all waste. Dogs are not permitted at the communal campfire.
- Do not enter the sheds, other buildings on the property, yards or animal enclosures without prior permission.
- Children must be supervised by an adult.
- Do not drive private vehicles around the farm.
- Speed limit is 10KM/ hr. Please be aware of children on our station.
- On arrival, please check-in at the homestead and complete our bio security visitor register.

By respecting our rules, we'll all have a great time. If you don't, you will be asked to leave. No refunds will be offered.
