

## Korknisse (aka Cork Gnome Dude)

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This pattern fits a small wine cork. It's knit with worsted weight yarn & 3mm - 4mm needles

Note by Saartje: I knit this pattern in the round. I had to adapt the number of stockinette rounds between the decreases\* to accommodate the larger corks.

Peggy notes: It is faster to knit flat and sew seams.

Use the yarn tails to tie the 2 pieces together. It will keep them on and angled nicely yet able to come off to change corks.



### Sweater:

Cast on 15 sts.

Cuff: k1p1 [OR garter st] for 2 rnds [rows!].

Knit stockinette for 3 rnds.

Cast off. (cast off in purl on kit side for "turned under" edge.)

### Hat:

Cast on 15 sts.

Knit k1p1 cuff for 2 rnds.

Knit stockinette for 2 rnds.

\*k2tog, k3\* Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

k 1 rnd.

\*k2tog, k2\* Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

k 1 rnd.

\*k2tog, k1. Repeat from \* to end of rnd.

k 1 rnd.

k2tog till end of rnd.

(optional: add several 3-st I-cord rnds.)

Draw the thread through the remaining stitches.
