Reflective Bible Study Questions Ephesians 6:10-20 - The Armor of God

Which piece of the armor do you find hardest to "put on" daily? How does this affect your ability to stand firm in your faith? Identify one piece of armor (truth, righteousness, faith, etc.) you will focus on strengthening this week. Consider how this armor might help you resist a specific challenge in your life.
Reflective Bible Study Questions : John 17:15-17 - Sanctification through God's Truth

Commit to spending a few extra minutes in scripture each day this week, focusing on passages that address areas where you need to be strengthened in truth. Reflective Bible Study Questions Matthew 5:8 - The Pure in Heart

	Are there any areas of your heart where impure motives or bitterness may have taken root? How does this affect your relationship with God?
\Rightarrow	Pray for a heart of purity and ask God to reveal any attitudes or thoughts that need transformation. Throughout the week, practice seeing others and situations through the lens of purity, love, and humility.
	Reflective Bible Study Questions 1 Samuel 16:6-7 - God Looks at the

\Rightarrow	Are there ways you focus on outward appearance or accomplishments over the condition of your heart? How can you begin to value inner character more?
\Rightarrow	Journal about a time when your inner character was tested. Reflect on how you responded and what you learned. This week, focus on building inner qualities like kindness, integrity, and patience, trusting that God values these deeply.

Reflective Bible Study Questions 2 Corinthians 5:16-21 - The Ministry of Reconciliation

\Rightarrow	When has God's Word convicted or encouraged you in a significant way? How did it shape your actions or mindset?
\Rightarrow	Choose a verse to meditate on this week that addresses a current struggle or growth area in your life. Allow God's Word to deeply influence and guide your decisions.
	Reflective Bible Study Questions Romans 12:2 - The Renewing of the Mind
\Rightarrow	In what areas of your life do you feel influenced by worldly values rather than godly ones? What practices help you stay renewed and focused on God's will?
\Rightarrow	Practice taking thoughts captive this week, pausing to discern if they align with God's truth. Commit to replacing negative, worldly influences with scripture and prayer.
