Avalon Sober House – Rules and Expectations

Avalon Sober House (ASH) ascribes to and recommends that its residents live according to the 12 Step Principles and traditions. Our sober living environment is created upon that common ground, allowing each participant to be treated as an equal on his journey to better his life. The following is a general list. Should the owner(s) and /or Manager(s) of ASH determine that you are not following the letter and/or spirit of the following Rules & Expectations or are behaving in a manner deemed inappropriate for the environment you will be expelled. If you are expelled for any reason, all paid program fees and sobriety deposits will be forfeited.

Expulsion is 3 step process. 1. You will be given one verbal warning. 2. Should your non-compliance continue, you will then be given one written warning. 3. Should your non-compliance continue, you will then be expelled.

When you leave ASH, ASH will hold any property you leave up to 60 days. If you or a representative do not claim your property in 60 days, management will take possession and dispose of it. If you die or are expelled management will promptly notify the emergency contact(s) you have listed on this form regarding your property and expulsion.

- USE AND/OR POSSESION OF ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS OR PARAPHERNALIA: The use of ANY alcohol or other illegal mood-altering substance (i.e. illegal drugs or prescription medication taken in a manner other than the manner prescribed) is strictly prohibited. If you are under the influences of any prohibited substance or are found in possession of such a substance or related paraphernalia (on your person or in your living space), you will be expelled.
- **No Habit forming medications:** ASH is a no-tolerance sober home. Methadone, Suboxone, Adderall and Medical Marijuana are not allowed.
- **FAILURE TO PROVIDE URINE AND/OR BREATH SAMPLE:** A condition of your residence at ASH is your agreement to provide a urine and/or breath sample to be tested for toxicity as requested by Management, for any cause and at any time. Refusal to provide a requested sample will result in expulsion.
- **TRAFFICKING:** Any suspected drug dealing or running activity will result in expulsion and be referred to law enforcement.
 - SOBRIETY/PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS: in addition to complete abstinence from alcohol and other illegal mood-altering substances, the following are requirements during your residency at ASH:
 - Attend Monday night House Meetings. No Exceptions.
 - Attend occasional emergency House Meetings unless you have a work conflict.
 - o Attend at least three 12 –step meetings per week outside the House.
 - Obtain a sponsor outside the House within seven days of moving in.
 - Meet with a sponsor at least once per week in person.
 - ASH management may inspect your living area and belongings at any time without permission
 - Work the 12 Steps with your sponsor.
 - o Have at least one weekly Service Commitment
 - o At least once every three months, participate in outside volunteer work
 - Be employed or enrolled in a course of study or volunteer outside ASH at least hrs. p/wk.

- **FEES:** It is your responsibility to pay all fees to ASH when they are due, without exception. As of 7/1/2023, monthly program fees for new residents are \$750.00. A \$300 sober deposit is required on or before the first day of residence. Monthly fees are due on the first day of the month. A \$25 late charge will be assessed on the third of each month. Should a resident depart for any reason during the first four months of residence at ASH for any reason whatsoever, the resident will forfeit the sober deposit.
- **THEFT:** Any theft will result in immediate expulsion and be referred to law enforcement. Any suspected theft may result in expulsion and may be referred to law enforcement.
- **DAMAGE TO PROPERTY:** Any significant and/or willful damage to ASH structure and/or property may result in in expulsion and/or attachment of deposit funds to compensate for repairs.
- THREATS OR POSSESSION OF ANY WEAPONS: Any threat of physical violence, threat of suicide or suicide attempt, or any other threatened or attempted harm to others or self is prohibited and will result in expulsion and may be referred to law enforcement. The possession of any weapon (on your person or in your living space) will result in your expulsion and referral to law enforcement.
- **ABUSE**: Any physical or verbal abuse of another resident, a resident's guests, or any Manager of ASH will result in expulsion and may be referred to law enforcement.
- MAINTENANCE OF A PEACEFUL RECOVERY-ORIENTED ENVIRONMENT: You may not interfere with another resident's quiet enjoyment of ASH. Courtesy and consideration should be shown at all times when using television, radio, personal stereo, gaming and/or other computer devices. In addition, the hours between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM are considered quiet hours. Repeated noncompliance may result in expulsion.
- MAIL TAMPERING: Any tampering or interference with mail will result in expulsion and may be referred to law enforcement.
- **SEXUAL RELATIONSHIPS/RELATIONSHIPS:** ASH residents will abstain from sexual relations, solicitation, prostitution and/or the promotion thereof. Noncompliance will result in expulsion.

- **GUESTS:** No women are allowed in or on the premises of ASH for any reason. An exception may be made with prior notice to and approval of a Manager in the case of a female family member. No overnight guests of any gender are allowed.
- **CURFEW:** Curfew shall be 12:00 PM during the week and 1:00 AM on Friday and Saturday. You are expected to return to ASH every night by curfew. No overnight passes will be issued to ASH residents during their first 30 days of residence. Exceptions for late returns, overnights or extended stays away from ASH (after 30 days of residence) may be made with prior notice to and approval of a Manager, at the Manager's sole discretion. Repeated noncompliance may result in expulsion.
- **SMOKING:** Smoking anywhere on the premises other than in a designated smoking area is prohibited. There is no smoking on the front lawn, the front steps or the sidewalk in front of the house. There is no smoking in the house. Smoking in sleeping areas will result in immediate expulsion.
- FAILURE TO ADHERE TO PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS: You are expected to be accountable to the other residents
 and the management of ASH as to your sobriety status. In addition, expectations among residents include but are
 not limited to the following:

 Completing house jobs 	Attending the House meetings
 Keeping personal items out of public areas 	Making beds daily
Keeping public areas clean	Maintaining acceptable personal hygiene
 Responsible use of energy – lights, fans, etc. 	House upkeep
No food in bedrooms	Be out of your bedroom during the day

Repeated non-compliance may result in expulsion.

- **VOLUNTARY TERMINATION:** You are expected to provide Management with at least a 30 day notice of voluntary termination of residence. Your "out date" for purposes of fees, unless otherwise agreed in advance will be the date that both you and your belongings are removed from the house. The last month's rent will not be pro-rated if you move depart before the end of the month.
- **HOUSEHOLD NECESSITIES:** The cost for these items and for your share of the monthly meal is included in the \$750.00 monthly program fee.
- **BORROWING / LENDING:** Residents of ASH will not borrow or loan money, automobiles, or other items of great value to residents of ASH. Noncompliance may result in expulsion.

These general rules are subject to interpretation, supplement, and/or revision by the Management of Avalon Sober House.
