<b>BIBLICAL STUDIES</b>		
Introduction to the Old Testament (BIB 101)	In this class the student receives an overview of the Old Testament. The student will learn about the Authorship, historical background, Social significance and main events of each book.	3
Introduction to the New Testament (BIB 102)	In this class the student will receive an overview of the Books of the New Testament. Examination will be given to the authorship, themes, Events and doctrine of each book.	3
Basic Theology (THE 200)	A foundational study of the basic doctrines of the Bible	3
The Life of Christ (BIB 120)	This course involves a study of the Gospels as they relate to the life and Ministry of Jesus Christ.	3

College English 1 (ENG 102)	This course teaches grammar, mechanics, paragraph development and Essay writing techniques for effective writing at college level.	3

Introduction to Computers (CSC 100)	An introduction to the use of the computer and various software Applications.	3

Statistics in Psychology (PSY 305)	Introduction to statistical methodology in the social sciences.	3
Research Methods in Psychological Studies (PSY 310)	Acquaints the prospective researcher in the behavioral sciences with a Number of basic principles.	3
Introduction to Philosophy (PHI 301)	A survey and critical analysis of the various systems of philosophy and Philosophical ideas.	3
