What a Book-hog!!!

What reader doesn't love hedgehogs? For this craft, you'll create a hedgehog sculpture out of a discarded book. It takes a bit of patience, but the final product gives a woodland atmosphere to any desk or bookshelf!

What you'll need:

- A book with about a hundred pages
- 3 buttons: 2 for the eyes, 1 for the nose
- Glue

Instructions:

- 1. Start with the front page. Fold the left side of the page to the center of the book in the shape of a rectangle.
- 2. Take the top corner of the rectangle and fold it back in the shape of a triangle. Smooth out these folds so they hold.
- 3. (Optional) Take the bottom corner of the rectangle and fold it back in the shape of a triangle. Smooth out these folds so they hold. To save folding time (a lot of it), you can skip the bottom folds.



- 4. Repeat this process with the next page.
- 5. Keep folding. Once all the pages are folded you should have a wedge-shaped hedgehog snout.
- 6. To make your hog more stable, cut off the edges of the cover.
- 7. Now, it's time to decorate the face! Glue a button onto the front of the snout for the nose. Then glue on 2 buttons for the eyes.
- 8. (optional) To add ears, cut unused book pages into 2 teardrop shapes. Fold these and glue them on above the eyes.
- 9. (optional) You can add other decorations like a flower, bow, or top hat as wanted using felt or construction paper.
