
Create a Recycled Garden for Earth Day!!

April 22 is Earth Day, so it's a great time to plant a tree, be kind to nature, think about the environment, and find new ways to recycle. For this craft, you'll make a flower garden with recycled cardboard, paper, magazines, and fabric.

Materials:

- Cardboard
- Green marker
- Glue
- Recycled materials (paper, magazines, fabric)



Instructions:

- 1. Pick a few flower designs. Cut out the templates.
- 2. Pick out a few patterns from the recycled materials provided.
- 3. Use the flower stencils to trace outlines on the recycled materials. Cut them out.
- 4. Glue the flowers onto the cardboard at different heights. Not only do flowers grow to different heights, but you'll be able to fit more on.
- 5. Draw stems and leaves for the flowers using a green marker.
- 6. Add the final touches. Draw some bugs buzzing and worms crawling around your flowers.
