MARINA NEWS

Happy July, Captains!

Summer is in full swing, and the marina is buzzing with activity. With the slips filled and the harbor alive with boat traffic, we're thrilled to see everyone making the most of the weather and season.

As a reminder, **short hauls and week hauls** are available by request. Be sure to bring your stands and plan ahead if you're scheduling a haul-out. If you need help or have questions, don't hesitate to reach out to the Marina Committee. marina@southnorwalkboatclub.com

Slip Occupancy:

At this point in the season, **all boats should be occupying their assigned slips**. The Marina Committee will be conducting a full marina bed check in the coming week. Violation letters will be issued to members who are absent without prior notice or found to be in violation of any marina rules. If you know you'll be delayed or your slip will remain empty, you must notify the Marina Committee immediately.

Fourth of July Weekend & Fireworks – Plan Ahead:

With the **4th of July weekend** ahead and **fireworks night on Friday, July 3rd**, we want to remind everyone that the docks will be very, very busy - especially that evening.

If you're hosting guests aboard your boat, **please keep the docks clear of obstacles**. This is one of the biggest nights of the year on the docks and at the club - let's make it enjoyable and safe for all.

Be courteous, clean up after yourself, and most importantly - have a fun!

A few quick notes:

- **Dock Carts:** The dock carts are an amenity provided for the convenience of all members. They are intended for **loading and unloading only** - not for long-term personal use. We have clearly labeled carts for "clean only" use and "work carts" for tools and dirty items. Please respect these designations.

All carts must be returned to the designated cart storage areas and **not left behind your boat** or on the docks. Leaving carts behind inconveniences

fellow members and disrupts the shared use of club resources.

- **Dock Safety:** Please secure all lines and power cords, and keep dock areas clear of personal gear and tripping hazards.
- **All bagged garbage needs to be disposed of in the brown large dumpsters NOT in any of the containers at the top of the ramps or around the Tiki Bar!**

Transient & Guest Docking Policy

We always enjoy welcoming members from reciprocal clubs, our own members without assigned slips, and visiting boaters to the South Norwalk Boat Club.

To help ensure everyone has a safe and available place to tie up, we ask that you follow our Transient/Guest Docking Policy:

- If you do not have an assigned slip at the club and would like to bring your boat over for lunch, dinner, an overnight stay, or any other visit, please make arrangements **before arriving**.
- Contact the Bar or reach out to the Marina Committee in advance so we can confirm slip availability.
- Upon arrival, **check in with the bartender on duty** immediately. The bartender will confirm that you are in an approved, available slip.

Following this simple process helps us avoid conflicts with assigned slip holders and ensures a smooth experience for everyone.

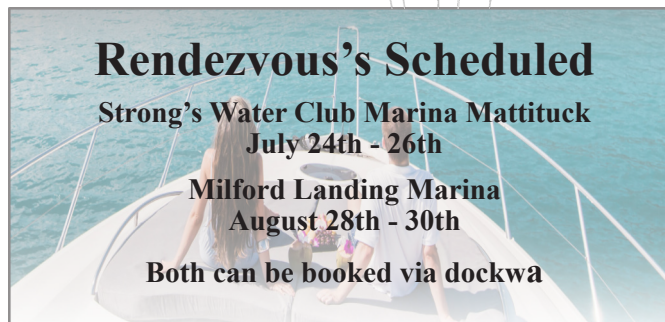
