## Marina News

We've officially entered the heart of summer - and with it comes extreme heat, late-summer storms, and continued high activity throughout the marina. Thank you all for your participation, care, and attention to the marina's operations so far this season.

### Heat & Storm Season Reminders:

With temperatures soaring and hurricane season approaching its peak, please be extra mindful of both personal safety and storm preparedness:|

- Hydrate and protect yourself and your guests from heat-related illness.
- Check fans, A/C units, and shore power cords for safe operation - avoid overloads.
- Prepare now for possible storms:
  - o Secure or upgrade dock lines and chafe gear
  - o Remove loose canvas, gear, and dock clutter
  - o Confirm bilge pumps and batteries are in working order
  - o Keep your contact info current with the Marina Committee

Please do not wait until the last minute - storm readiness is everyone's responsibility.

### Slip Compliance & Violations:

At this point in the season, all boats should be occupying their assigned slips. The Marina Committee has begun a full bed check, and violation letters have been sent to members who have not launched or failed to notify us of their absence.

Additionally, fine letters have been issued to members who remain out of compliance with required documentation. This includes valid registration, insurance, and OnlineMooring.com compliance. If you have any questions, please contact [marina@southboatclub.com](mailto:marina@southboatclub.com).

### Short Hauls & Week Hauls:

We are continuing to offer short hauls and week hauls by request. To schedule one, please complete a Haul-Out Request Form (located behind the bar) and remember to bring your own stands.

### No Parking in Yellow Spaces:

Please remember: there is no early morning or overnight parking in any yellow-marked spaces in the yard. We've repeated this often, and it's important that all members follow it.

These areas are kept clear for volunteers and equipment involved in hauling, blocking, and yard work. Unauthorized vehicles interfere with operations and risk damage to both your car and club equipment.

Your cooperation helps us keep things running safely and efficiently.

### Quick Reminders:

- Dock Carts: For loading/unloading only. Respect "clean only" and "work cart" labels, and always return carts to their storage areas - do not leave them by your boat.
- Dock Safety: Keep docks clear of cords, hoses, gear, and clutter. Always secure your power lines and lines properly.
- Courtesy Matters: Be mindful of noise levels, especially at night. Let's keep our club enjoyable and respectful for all.

We're heading into the final stretch of summer - let's finish strong with preparedness, safety, and shared respect for one another and the marina. We appreciate everyone who does their part to uphold the standards of the South Norwalk Boat Club.


