# MARINA NEWS

The marina has now been officially open for a full month, and we're excited to share that **all 104 stored boats have been successfully launched!** Thanks to two efficient Saturday work parties, we completed the entire launch operation in under 2 days!

This incredible achievement would not have been possible without the help of our dedicated volunteers. Thank you to everyone who showed up to assist with launching, cooking, cleanup, and ensuring a safe and smooth process. Now, with the marina starting to fill, we're all looking forward to a fantastic boating season ahead!

## Haul-Out Services Now Available

We are now accepting applications for haul-out services. Boat owners have two options:

- **Short Haul:** 2-hour lift and hang in slings
- **Week Haul:** Boat blocked and stored for one week

If you choose the Week Haul, you must bring your own boat stands, be ready to power wash, and assist with blocking your boat.

## Online Documentation System

Our new online tracking system, **OnlineMooring.com**, has been a huge help in organizing marina information. All boat owners must upload their **insurance, registration, and signed Terms and Conditions** (contract) through this system before entering the marina. 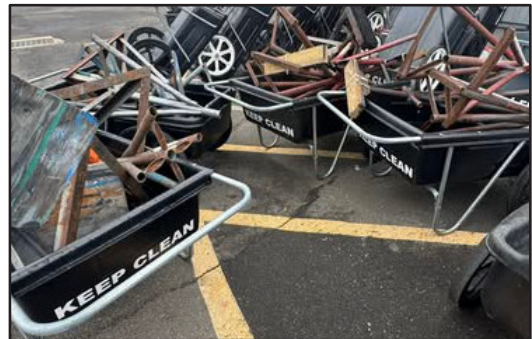
## Important Reminders:

- Boat registrations and insurance policies must be in the name of the captain or captain/spouse – **no exceptions.**
- Insurance policies must include a minimum of **\$300,000 liability per incident**, with **South Norwalk Boat Club** listed as an additional insured.

## Outside Contractors

If you hire outside contractors to work at the club, they must submit liability and worker's compensation certificates, naming **South Norwalk Boat Club** as an additional insured. Insurance requirements are as follows:

- **Commercial General Liability:** \$1,000,000 occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate
- **Commercial Auto Coverage:** \$1,000,000 combined single limit
- **Worker's Compensation:** \$100,000 each accident / \$500,000 disease each employee / \$100,000 disease policy limit
- **Umbrella Policy:** \$1,000,000 (General contractors)
- **\$5,000,000 Umbrella Policy:** Required for contractors working throughout the full yard (e.g., shrink-wrap services)



## Dock Carts Reminder

We have over 30 dock carts available for members' use.

- Carts are labeled either "**Keep Clean**" or "**Work Cart.**" Please use the correct cart for your needs and wipe it down after use.
- Always return carts to the storage areas after unloading your boat. **Do not leave carts on the docks** — others need them too, especially during busy days.

**Failure to comply with club regulations will result in fines and loss of marina privileges.**

# Auxiliary News

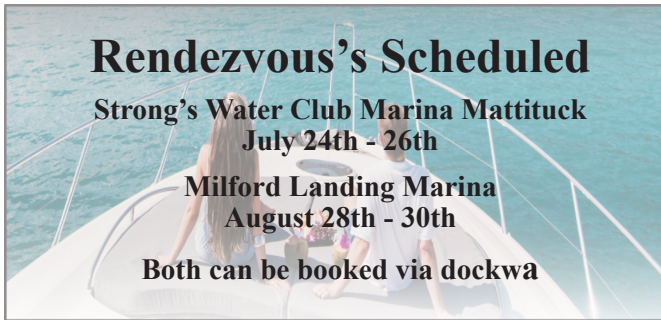
Aux members will be volunteering for Filling in the Blanks (FIB) on June 23rd. Please join us as we help fight childhood hunger—Captains are welcome too.
