Please note that boat registrations and insurance policies must be in the name of a captain or captain/spouse. No exceptions.

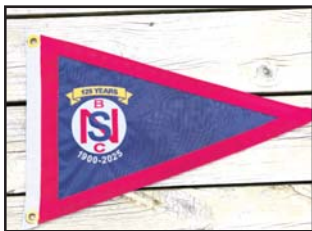

5 Calcutta's

Biggest yellowfin \$200

Biggest bluefin \$200

Biggest overall tuna \$200

Biggest sword and thresher shark \$200 (split)

Biggest fluke and seabass \$200 (split)

Get in one or all. Calcutta's are winner take all

This is a per boat tournament not a personal tournament.

## RULES

Leave or pass Montauk jetty no earlier than 5am Friday, July 11th. Photo of GPS screen to show time and location when leaving or passing and returning to show time at sea.

Pick any 2 days during tournament offshore and any 2 days inshore. Boats can fish 4 straight days or 1 day at a time. Total time jetty to jetty is 48 hours for inshore and 48 hours offshore.

Captains may change crews for different days.

All fish must be weighed in at a marina in Montauk. A time stamp photo of fish and weigh scale. All weigh ins must be emailed to [tuna84@aol.com](mailto:tuna84@aol.com) or [ttingets@gmail.com](mailto:ttingets@gmail.com) or texted to 203-984-9025 or 203-515-9624 on day of weigh in.

Boats must enter tournament and Calcutta by Thursday, July 10. Boat entry sign up at bar. Calcutta sign up can be done by contacting Paul Hiller at [tuna84@aol.com](mailto:tuna84@aol.com) or text at 203-984-9025. You may sign up for calcuttas at Captains meeting.

All fishing laws must be adhered to. All IGFA rules must be adhered to. Boats must have tuna and shark permits. Crew must have fishing license.

Captains are responsible for the safety of their crew.

In case of a tie in Calcutta category, the first boat to weigh in the fish will be declared the winner.

Tournament is open to area clubs.

An awards BBQ will be at SNBC on Sunday, August 24 at 3:00 PM.  
5 wristbands per boat. Additional wristbands can be purchased in advance of the BBQ.
