### Marina News

Hello Captains, September is here, and while summer isn't over yet, we are entering peak storm season. Please take a few minutes to review your storm-prep plans and secure your vessels accordingly. Even when storms track offshore, strong winds, heavy rain, and surge can create challenges in the marina if boats aren't properly tied off.

Let's stay prepared and make the most of the boating days we still have ahead

### **Haul-Out & Scheduling:**

- All short hauls and week hauls must be completed by the end of September.
- All hauling and storage forms must be submitted before October 1st.
- Early Bird Hauling: Friday, October 4th at 7:30 AM.
- Final Haul-Out Weekend: Saturday & Sunday, October 24 & 25 starting at 8:00 AM.
- Please note: All haul-out dates are subject to change depending on weather or operational needs.
- If you plan on hauling your boat, please be prepared to **powerwash your own hull** or **lend a hand when possible**.
- All members storing their boats in the yard are required to provide their own keel blocks and boat stands, which must be onsite and ready the day of your haul-out.

### **Parking Lot Reminder**

Please remember: NO OVERNIGHT OR EARLY MORNING PARKING IN THE MARKED YELLOW SPACES.

The travel lift may be in operation anytime between **6:30 AM and 7:30 PM**. Vehicles left in these spaces risk interfering with hauling operations and will slow down the schedule for everyone.

### Marina & Yard Safety

- For boats stored on land, shore power and extension cords must be unplugged when unattended and never left plugged in overnight.
- Heating devices of any type are strictly prohibited in boats on land or in water.
- During haul-out, please keep clear of the travel lift and follow the directions of the crew at all times.
- As storms approach, check and double-check your **dock lines, fenders, and power cords -** it helps protect your boat and your neighbors'.

### **Transient Slips**

At times, the marina has **transient slips available for visiting members and guests**. Whether you're coming over for lunch, dinner, a day trip, or an overnight stay, we're happy to welcome you.

If you're planning a short visit, it's always best to check in about availability so we can accommodate everyone. We love to see the marina being used to its full potential - so take a run over when you can!


### **Final Note**
