MARINA NEWS

Welcome to the 2026 boating season! The marina officially opened April 1st!

Over the winter, we made significant progress behind the scenes. We are pleased to report that we have received our **approved dredging permits** and are actively working through planning and next steps. In addition, we are evaluating and preparing for **dock modifications** to improve safety throughout the marina.

We will also be releasing **updated marina rules** shortly—please keep an eye out for those in the coming weeks.

The club will soon be in full swing as we prepare the marina, yard, and grounds for the season.

All winter covers and shrink wrap must be removed by the end of the day April 12th.

Frank Guthman Jr. will once again be donating his dumpster for shrink wrap disposal — **THANK YOU AGAIN, FRANK!**

The dumpster will be delivered during the first week of April and will remain onsite for approximately two weeks.

IMPORTANT:

- ONLY shrink wrap is to be placed in this dumpster
- **NO wood or other materials are permitted**
- Do NOT place shrink wrap, wood, or debris in the club's regular garbage or recycling dumpsters

Our first launch is tentatively scheduled for **Saturday, April 18th at 8:00 AM**. We expect to launch at least the front 2–3 rows.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

- Registration and insurance policies must be in the name of the **Captain or Captain/Spouse only — NO exceptions**
- All insurance policies must carry a minimum of **\$300,000 liability per incident**
- **South Norwalk Boat Club must be listed as Additional Insured**

Outside Contractor Requirements

Any member bringing in an outside contractor must ensure that all required documentation is submitted and approved prior to work beginning.

Minimum Requirements:

- **Commercial General Liability**
 - \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - \$2,000,000 aggregate
 - SNBC listed as Additional Insured
- **Commercial Auto**
 - \$1,000,000 combined single limit
- **Worker's Compensation**
 - \$100,000 each accident
 - \$500,000 disease each employee
 - \$100,000 disease policy limit
- **Umbrella Policy**
 - \$1,000,000 minimum
 - \$5,000,000 required for contractors working in a full yard (e.g., shrink wrap contractors)

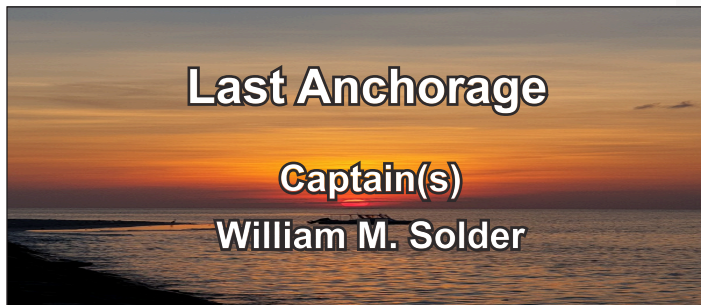
