- ☐ Business Documents & Practices: A review of your organizational and legal documentation.
- ☐ Aircraft: An inspection of the aircraft used for training.
- ☐ Training Sample: A sampling of your ground and flight training procedures.

Please note that a cost will be associated with this evaluation.

Initial Business & Skill Assessment Guidance

As you prepare for the formal evaluation, we ask you to review the following critical areas. These represent the fundamental criteria the UPRT Network assesses to ensure all accredited members operate with the necessary legal, financial, and operational integrity.

Business & Operational Readiness

Before applying, please ensure you have the following in place:

1. Legal & Financial Standing: Are you operating as a legal business in compliance with all state and federal laws? Do you possess the necessary financial and legal documents to fully support your operations?
2. Insurance: Are you properly insured for all your flight operations and training activities?
3. Facilities: Do you have (or have access to) proper ground training facilities suitable for the effective delivery of your UPRT curriculum?
4. Regulatory Compliance: Do your operations and maintenance practices conform to all current FAA regulatory requirements?
5. Equipment: Do you possess all the proper equipment needed for the specific training you provide?
6. Syllabus & Curriculum: Do you have a comprehensive, well-structured syllabus for each UPRT course you offer?

We seek partners who are fully dedicated to pursuing excellence. Your final consideration should be:

7. Are you willing to pursue membership/accreditation via a formal, comprehensive evaluation of all the above criteria by current members of the Upset Prevention and Recovery Network?
