My Father's House: Tefeya orphan home updates

On July 17th – 19th, My Father's House Tefeya Orphan Home celebrated its seventh anniversary with three days of fun activities. We just want to thank all of our donors for partnering with them to provide a safe home for all these amazing children of God!

This orphan home currently has fourteen kids. On 7/25/23, three of the kids (Deborah, Faith & Ezekiel) traveled to Kaiyima, twenty-five miles away, to take their external examination to complete their basic education certificate. They were gone through August 6th (13 days).

The kids and staff have begun clearing land around the orphanage to plant peppers. This project's name is the "Tefeya Agricultural Project". There are several varieties of peppers in Sierra Leone. When seedlings are received, they have been planting without differentiating on the plot. The Neneh Koro is the specific pepper that is favored locally in the country. Please enjoy a few of the photos they have sent working on this project.

Widow's Ministry:

Praise the Lord that The Light of the World Ministries, along with Wordsower International, is now reaching 120 widows. Our widows are in Waterloo & Moribatown. Please pray that we reach and impact widows that are in the remote regions of the county that are without support and encouragement.

Gboyama:

Pastor Dennis is the pastor of the Gboyama church and the Headmaster of My Father's House Gyoyama orphan home. His family home burned down this month. His family of five have moved into the living room space of the Gboyama orphanage until funds come in to rebuild their house. The Light of The World Ministry has set up a Pastor Assistant Fund, and, because of generous contributions, we sent the funds needed.

Waterloo Boys & Girl's Orphanages:

The boys needed to be out of their home by August 1st, so the building project began on our land in Foya. There are several buildings that will be built on this piece of property, and you will be hearing about special construction needs this upcoming year. During July, the widows of Waterloo got together with the orphan homes and spent time together. God's family is lovely to be a part of.

Prayer & Financial Needs:

The Light of The World Ministries' mission is to care for orphans, widows and to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all, focusing on the country of Sierra Leone, West Africa. We have some prayer requests and action items for you this month.

1. We are trying to update Facebook several times weekly with photos and videos from our orphans' & widows' homes. In these posts, we may list immediate prayer or financial needs. Here is a link to our Facebook page: [Facebook](#)
2. We have purchased land in Foya and have a desire to move all the orphans from Waterloo to Foya this year. Along with that, we would like to build facilities on site including a school, kitchen, bathrooms, staff, and mission quarters. This is a big project that requires above and beyond normal monthly donations. Every structure costs approximately \$10,000 US dollars. Please pray about this building project.
3. Would you pray about becoming a monthly supporter? Could you do: \$50, \$25, or even \$10 a month? Money has been very tight the past few months, and we have not been able to send what we feel is needed to support our orphans, widows, staff, and pastors.

It takes less than 5 minutes to set up a Zelle money transfer through your bank's app. It's free to submit payments through Zelle, and the funds are deposited the same day into our account without any transfer fees.
